## LASQUETI ISLAND'S SQUITTY BAY PROTECTED FOREVER

This year, more than 150 organizations and individuals helped realize the community's dream of protecting a beautiful and cherished part of Lasqueti Island. The hidden bays and beaches, rugged coastal bluffs, and rare ecosystems of Squitty Bay are now protected forever as part of an expanded Squitty Bay Provincial Park.

### Terry Tyler and Ingrid Iversen took the first step

The former owners had a vision of their oceanfront property being protected forever. In 2006 the couple offered to sell the property to BC Parks for less than market value. BC Parks agreed to buy the ecologically sensitive property as long as the community could raise \$250,000 towards its purchase.
