The Islands Trust Fund was named a finalist in the 2011 Land Awards for its work in regional conservation planning. The Land Awards, sponsored by the Real Estate Foundation of British Columbia, recognize initiatives demonstrating leadership, innovation, and collaboration in sustainable land use projects. Along with a select group of other non-profit, private and public leaders in the field, the Islands Trust Fund was recognized for its 2011-2015 Regional Conservation Plan.

The 2011-2015 Regional Conservation Plan takes an innovative approach to identifying the most at-risk areas in the islands and provides a broad spectrum of strategies to protect natural values, from land acquisition and private land stewardship to researching ways to protect biodiversity on working landscapes. Engaging more than twenty conservation agencies and non-profit organizations in its development, the Plan identifies a shared vision for the future of the islands, and sets out an agenda of partnership to achieve that vision.
